We are hosting a workshop, on August 6th and 7th, to explain the importance of Sibshop programs and to train staff how to facilitate the service delivery.

We are looking for two groups of volunteers to assist us in this workshop. Lunch will be provided each day free of charge:

August 6th (Tuesday) 9am - 3:30pm we need Adult siblings (18 and older) to sit on a panel to share their experiences as a sibling with us. *Panelists frequently remark that they, too, leave with an expanded understanding of the sibling experience as a result of listening to other panelists.*

August 7th (Wednesday) 10am – 2pm we need siblings preferably between the age of 8 to 10 years old. *These children will partake in a sibshop being run to teach the prospective facilitators. Most of these children will be eligible to enroll in the program and continue to participate on a monthly basis free of charge.*
